AN ACT to Establish a Mandatory One-year License Suspension for a Second Violation of a Municipal Shellfish Conservation Ordinance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 6404-A is enacted to read:

§ 6404-A. Suspension based on 2nd conviction of violating a municipal shellfish conservation ordinance

The commissioner shall suspend the shellfish license of any license holder convicted in court of a 2nd or subsequent violation of section 6671 or any municipal shellfish conservation ordinance adopted under that section. The suspension shall be for one year.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires a suspension of a shellfish license for one year if the license holder is convicted of a 2nd or subsequent violation of any municipal shellfish conservation ordinance.
