IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT Concerning Registration of Killed Deer.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 2355, sub-§ 3, ¶A, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to repeal the requirement that a killed deer cannot be stored more than 12 hours without being registered. This law creates a great hardship on hunters who kill a deer while in a hunting camp and do not return to a municipality having a deer registration station within 12 hours.
