COMMITTEE OF CONFERENCE AMENDMENT" A" to S.P. 199, L.D. 495, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Occupational Loss of Hearing."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'39 MRSA §193, sub-§3, 2nd sentence, as enacted by PL 1967, c. 374, §6, is amended to read:

Hearing levels shall be measured by means of pure-tone ear-con-duction audiometric instruments calibrated in accordance with American Standard-Z24,5,-1951,-American-Stand---ards-Association,-March-21,-1951-National Standards Institute

Standard S3.22-1976, and in an area with ambient noise level within the limits specified in American Standards Association

Criteria for Background Noise in Audiometric Room S3.1, 1960.'

Statement of Fact

The purposes of this amendment are to:

- Correct a minor error in the statutes by changing "earconduction" to 'air-conduction;' and
 - 2. Change the calibration standards.
