# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

#### AN ACT Relating to Furloughs for Inmates of County Jails.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

34 MRSA § 1008, first paragraph, last sentence, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 191, § 2, is amended to read:

Furlough may be granted for not more than 3 days at one time in order to permit the prisoner to visit a dying relative or to obtain medical services, which may be for a period of longer than 3 days if medically required **or for any other reason consistent with the treatment and rehabilitation of an inmate or prisoner**.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill gives the sheriff the authority to place prisoners in residential treatment facilities, thereby enhancing the opportunities for treatment and rehabilitation.
