COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 422, L.D. 517, Bill,
"AN ACT to Amend Existing Stumpage Allowance to the Passamaquoddy
Indian Tribe."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the
amending clause and before the Statement of Fact and inserting
in its place the following:

'At the end of each fiscal year all net income from the
sale of timber and grass from Indian Township shall be
distributed in equal amounts to the Passamaquoddy Tribal Councils
of Pleasant Point and Indian Township.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that net income from the sale of
timber and grass from Indian Township be distributed in equal
amounts to the Passamaquoddy Tribal Councils of Pleasant Point
and Indian Township.
