STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Amend Existing Stumpage Allowance to the Passamaquoddy Indian Tribe.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

22 MRSA § 4834, 2nd \P, as repealed and replaced by PL 1969, c. 217, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

At the end of each fiscal year all net income from the sale of timber and grass from Indian Township shall be transmitted in the Passamaquoddy Tribe Trust Funds.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide that 100% of net income from the sale of stumpage at Indian Township be placed in the Passamaquoddy Tribe Trust Funds.
