STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Exempt from the Sales Tax Sales to Nonprofit Public Residential Drug
Treatment Centers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- 36 MRSA § 1760, sub-§ 41 is enacted to read:
- 41. Sales to nonprofit public residential drug treatment centers. Sales to any nonprofit public residential drug treatment center.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill excludes from the state sales tax all sales to nonprofit public residential drug treatment centers.
