HOUSE AMENDMENT" A"to H.P. 435, L.D. 552, Bill, "AN ACT to Require that all Public Employees be Paid at Least the Federal Minimum Wage."

Amend the bill by striking out all of Section 3.

Further amend the bill by renumbering Sections 4 and 5 to be sections 3 and 4.

Statement of Fact

Section 3 of the bill sets a \$4 ceiling on the minimum

wage which is geared to the federal minimum wage, presently
1979, chapter 54,

2.90. Public law / has already established the ceiling

as \$4 and has also established the minimum wage to be at least

\$2.90 and to keep up with the federal level. The intent of
1979, chapter 54,
section 3 has already been accomplished by public law / so

this amendment merely strikes out section 3 of the bill.
