COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " $\hat{A}$ " to H.P. 459, L.D. 572, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Fatal Motor Vehicle Accidents."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'29 MRSA §891, 3rd¶,as/amended by PL 1975, c. 731, §43, is further amended by inserting at the end the following new sentence:

If the accident results in serious bodily injury or death of any person, the investigation shall be conducted by an officer who has met the training standards of a full-time police officer, if one is reasonably available.'

## Statement of Fact

This amendment simplifies the language, provides that investigate, a trained officer shall / if one is reasonably available, and removes the criminal penalty for failure to comply with the provision.
