STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Extend the Educational Programs at the Maine Youth Center.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

15 MRSA \S 2712, first \P , as repealed and replaced by PL 1975, c. 756, \S 6, is amended by adding at the end the following new sentence:

Any educational programs conducted at the center for the education of the children committed there shall be conducted during the entire year and shall not be suspended or reduced during any part of the year.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Currently, regular educational programs at the Maine Youth Center are not held in the summer. This bill would require that regular courses be held year-round.
