COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 498, L.D. 622, Bill,  
"AN ACT Regulating Hunting with Muzzle-loading Rifles."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the last paragraph  
before the statement of fact and inserting in its place  
the following:

'A muzzle-loading rifle shall be deemed to be legally  
transportable by vehicle under section 2456 if the percussion  
cap or flint is removed from the ignition system, even  
though the rifle may have powder and lead in the breach of  
the barrel. All other provisions of section 2456 shall  
apply to hunting with muzzle-loading rifles.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment requires flints to be removed from  
flintlock rifles for their safe transportation.
