STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Require Lobstermen to Use Only One Buoy Color Combination.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 6421, sub-§ 6, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 661, § 5, is amended to read:

6. Buoy colors. Each applicant shall describe, on the application the **a single**, **unique** color design of his buoys.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires that a lobster fisherman only use one color combination and design on all of his lobster buoys.
