# RESOLVE, to Provide a Minimum Retirement Credit to Shirley Quint of Hodgdon.

Shirley  $\frac{2}{3}$  Quint; state retirement benefits authorized. Resolved: That, notwithstanding any other provisions of law, the Maine State Retirement System is directed to provide Shirley Quint of Hodgdon with a pension of \$100 per month for the remainder of her lifetime, unless she becomes the dependent of another person, at which time benefits shall cease.

### STATEMENT OF FACT

This resolve will provide Shirley Quint of Hodgdon with a pension of \$100 per month for the rest of her life or until she becomes the dependent of another person.
