STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Prohibit Fishing for Atlantic Salmon in any Territorial Waters in this State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 2552, sub-§ 7, as last amended by PL 1975, c. 772, § 13, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

7. Atlantic Salmon. No person shall fish for Atlantic sea run salmon in any territorial waters of this State.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to prohibit fishing for Atlantic salmon in any territorial waters of Maine.
