STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Prohibit Commerce in Atlantic Salmon in the State of Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 2751, first paragraph, first sentence, is amended to read:

It shall be unlawful for any person to sell or buy, directly or indirectly, any landlocked salmon, **Atlantic salmon**, trout, togue, black bass, white perch or pickerel, except that pickerel may be sold in Washington County.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to make it unlawful for any person to sell or by Atlantic salmon in the State.
