IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to the Criminal History Record Information.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- **16 MRSA** § **602, sub-**§ **2,** ¶**E,** as enacted by PL 1975, c. 763, § 3, is amended to read:
 - **E.** Records of traffic offenses including traffic infractions, maintained by the Secretary of State except for violations of Title 29, sections 893 and 1312 and except for those violations resulting in revocation of license pursuant to Title 29, section 1313: and

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to make the record of homicide with a motor vehicle and operating under the influence convictions accessible.

This is necessary for the rating of automobile insurance with poor drivers being surcharged for convictions. Without the availability of this information, the cost would be shared by all drivers.
