COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 553, L.D. 700, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide Continued Educational Benefits for Veterans' Widows after Remarriage."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in its place the following. 'The remarriage of the widow or widower of a veteran shall not bar the furnishing of benefits to the widow or widower of the veteran if the remarriage has been terminated by death or has been disolved by a divorce and the benefits are paid within 10 years of first eligibility.'

Statement of Fact

The amendment limits the period during which the remarried widow may collect benefits to 10 years from first eligibility.
