STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Make Private Organizations which Receive a State Subsidy Subject to the Maine Freedom of Access Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- 1 MRSA § 402, sub-§ 2, ¶D is enacted to read:
- D. Any private organization which receives for its operation revenues from a state tax.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to require that state-related, private organizations which receive part of their operating funds from the State (e.g., the Maine Potato Council) be subject to the Maine Freedom of Access Law.
