'Further amend the Bill in section 2 by striking out all of that part designated "§3021." and inserting in its place the following:

## §3021. Other plans allowed

The provisions of this chapter shall not be construed to

prohibit any other type of prepaid legal service plans permitted

under the laws of this State.'
