HOUSE AMENDMENT " " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 644,
L.D. 798, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide Restitution to Innocent Victims of
Crimes."

Amend the Amendment on page 4 by striking out all of subsection 2 of that part designated "§4204." and inserting in its place the following:

- '2. Persons ineligible. The following persons shall be ineligible for awards:
 - A. A person who is criminally responsible for the crime on which a claim is based;
 - B. An accomplice of a person described in paragraph A; and
 - C. A member of the family of a person described in paragraph
 - A, a person living with him or a person maintaining sexual relations with him.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify provisions of the committee amendment with respect to exclusion of certain persons eligible to receive reimbursement.
