STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Require Insurance Claim Payments Because of Motor Vehicle Damage to Include Payment for the Reduction in the Trade-in Value of the Motor Vehicle.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

29 MRSA § 833 is enacted to read:

§ 833. Trade-in value reduction

Any claim payment made by an insurance company under a motor vehicle liability policy because of damage to a motor vehicle caused by an accident shall include in that payment an amount equal to the reduction in the trade-in value of that vehicle at the time of the payment, which reduction was caused by the damage suffered because of that accident.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides that when an insurance company pays a claim for damage to a motor vehicle because of an accident, the claim must include an amount equal to the reduction in the trade-in value of that motor vehicle caused by the accident.
