STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT Concerning the Issuance of Work Permits and Charging of Fees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

26 MRSA § 1316 is enacted to read:

§ 1316. Permits and fees

If a state, district or country requires a permit or charges residents of this State any fee as a condition for securing or retaining employment, the director shall require like permit or fee from residents of that state, district or country for securing or retaining employment in Maine.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Currently, Maine workers may be required to obtain special work permits in order to seek employment in some places outside the State. This bill would require residents from those places where special permits or fees are required of Maine residents to seek permits based on the same standards in order to work in Maine.
