HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P.663, L.D. 838, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Statutes Relating to Airmobiles."

Amend the amendment by inserting before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Further amend the Bill in section 8, subsection 10, by inserting at the end after paragraph D \(\to\) the following:

E. All areas of the State shall be closed to the operation of airmobiles until each area is opened to such use by regulation of the commissioner. In promulgating these regulations for each area of the State, the commissioner shall consider the impact of the operation of airmobiles on other watercraft, fisheries and wildlife habitat and the natural environment. These regulations shall be promulgated in accordance with the Maine Adminstrative Procedure Act, Title 5, chapter 375, after public hearings in each of the areas affected.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide for closing all areas of the State to the operation of airmobiles until each area is opened to such use by regulation of the commissioner. TT. a la . . . \
