STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Amend the Form of Election Ballots to Omit the Secretary of State's Name under Certain Conditions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. 21 MRSA § 701, sub-§ 2, ¶G is amended to read:
- **G.** Printed on the outside. On the front and back of the folded ballot must be printed "Official (name of political party) Primary Ballot for (Name of voting place for which ballot was prepared)" and the date of the election and a facsimile of the signature of the Secretary of State.
- Sec. 2. 21 MRSA § 702, sub-§ 3 is amended to read:
- **3. Printed on outside.** On the front and back of the folded ballot must be printed "Official Ballot for (name of voting district)" **and** the date of the election and a facsimile of the signature of the Secretary of State.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill prevents the Secretary of State's name from appearing on ballots, in his official capacity, if he is a candidate for nomination or election.
