STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Prevent Game Wardens from Trapping in the Area in Which They Work.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 2005 is enacted to read:

§ 2005. Wardens prohibited from trapping

No inland fish and game warden shall trap in the warden district to which he is assigned or in any warden district adjacent thereto.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to prevent trapping by fish and game wardens in the areas in which they work.
