COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " To H.P. 780, L.D. 973, RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine to Maintain and Protect the Integrity of the Maine State Retirement System.

Amend the Resolution in the 11th line (10th line in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined words "employer costs" the underlined words 'for state employees and teachers'

Further amend the Resolution by striking out all of the 3rd paragraph before the Statement of Fact and inserting in its place the following: '"Shall the Constitution of Maine be amended to require sufficient appropriations to the Maine State Retirement System to pay the current employer costs of the Retirement System for state employees and teachers?"'

Statement of Fact

This amendment makes it clear that the Constitutional amendment only applies to state employee and teacher employer costs and rewords the question to be presented at the referendum to provide a better description of the amendment.
