SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 784, L.D. 984, Bill, "AN ACT to Permit Certain Maine Pharmacists to Fill the Prescription of Certain Nonresident Physicians."

Amend the Bill by inserting before the enacting clause the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, there is an urgent need along the borders of this State for authority to fill nonresident prescriptions; and

Whereas, legislation is necessary to allow people in these communities who use services of nonresident physicians to continue to obtain proper medications; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of and Maine/require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'

Further amend the Bill by inserting before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'
