# AN ACT Relating to Appropriating Funds for Certain Municipal Governments.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

In order to provide assistance for some of the necessary expenditures of certain municipal governments, an amount not to exceed the amounts listed in this Act or an equal proration if sufficient funds are not available, shall be expended from any balances available in the general purpose aid for local schools from the fiscal year 1980 appropriations. The sums shall be paid by the Treasurer of State not later than April 1, 1980.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to deal with the problem of pay-ins within school administrative districts and community districts.
