STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT Concerning Eligibility Under the Second Injury Fund Under the Workers' Compensation Statutes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

39 MRSA § 57, as last amended by PL 1977, c. 612, § 6, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

This section shall apply to all cases of total permanent impairment falling under the provisions of this section regardless of when the industrial injury occurred.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to make persons who were totally disabled prior to 1975 eligible under the Second Injury Fund.
