COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A" to H.P. 842, L.D. 1044, Bill,
"AN ACT to Authorize the Bureau of Public Lands to Lease Lands
in the Intertidal Zone Adjacent to Permanent Structures."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'12 MRSA §514-A, sub-§2, ¶A, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 287, \$1, is amended by inserting after the first sentence the following: He may also lease, for a period of not more than 5 years, a buffer zone of not more than 30 feet in width around a permanent structure located on submerged or intertidal land, provided the lease is necessary to preserve the integrity and safety of the structure, and the Commissioner of Marine Resources consents to that lease.'

## Statement of Fact

This amendment restricts leasing of public lands adjacent to structures on intertidal land to the area necessary to preserve the safety and integrity of the structure.
