COMMITTEE AMENDMENT" (To H.P. 841, L.D. 1069, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Resident State Police Troopers."

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. In addition to such funds committed by local tax authority, there is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Safety, Bureau of State Police, the sum of \$15,166 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1980, and \$13,613 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1981, and there is allocated from the income of the General Highway Fund the sum of \$45,496 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1980, and \$40,852 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1981, to be used exclusively to carry out the purposes of this Act. These funds shall not lapse. The breakdown shall be as follows:
