HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P.
910, L.D. 1133, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Abuse Between Family
or Household Members."

Amend the Amendment on page 2, by striking out all
of paragraphs B, C and D of subsection 2 of that part
designated "§1331." and inserting in their place the
following:

'B. Not to visit, or to visit only at certain times
or under certain conditions, any child residing with the
victim; or

C. To abstain from offensive physical contact against
the victim.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to conform the bill to the
constitutional requirement of fair warning in criminal
statutes by removing vague language from the bill, pursuant
to an Attorney General's opinion.
