SENATE AMENDMENT" "to H.P. 898, L.D. 1136, Bill,

"AN ACT to Improve Election Laws and to Make Equal Application
of Legal Requirements for Independents, Democrats and Republicans in all Respects."

Amend the bill in section 2 by inserting at the end the following new paragraph:

## Statement of Facts

The bill provides an opportunity for candidates seeking nomination by petition in an uncontested race to file nomination petitions on primary dates rather than on April 1st. The purpose is to provide greater opportunity for public participation in elections by encouraging challenged rather than uncontested elections.
