STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, to Provide Minimum Retirement Benefits for Alfred R. Skolfield of Corinth.

Alfred R. Skolfield; state retirement benefits authorized. Resolved: That, notwithstanding any other provisions of law, the Maine State Retirement System shall provide Alfred R. Skolfield of Corinth with a minimum retirement benefit of \$100 a month for the remainder of his lifetime, unless he becomes the dependent of another person, at which time benefits shall cease; and be it further

Return of accumulated contributions prior to commencement of benefits. Resolved: That the benefits provided by this Resolve shall not commence until Alfred R. Skolfield contributes to the retirement system the equivalent of his accumulated contributions, with interest, which he previously withdrew from the retirement system.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides a minimum retirement benefit of \$100 a month, and thereafter as adjusted for cost-of-living by Title 5, section 1128, to Alfred R. Skolfield of Corinth for the rest of his life or until he becomes the dependent of another person. Since Mr. Skolfield previously withdrew his contributions from the retirement system, these benefits will not commence until he contributes the equivalent of those contributions, with interest, to the retirement system.
