**AN ACT to Permit Hunting until 1/2 Hour After Sunset During Open Season on Deer.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**12 MRSA § 2455, 2nd ¶, last sentence**, as amended by PL 1971, c. 622, § 43, is repealed as follows:

~~Except that it shall be unlawful to hunt wild animals in the State from sunset to 1/2 hour before sunrise of the following morning, except raccoons, during the open season on deer hunting with firearms each year~~

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to permit hunting until 1/2 hour after sunset during deer hunting season.
