**AN ACT Relating to Holding Tanks for New Seasonal Dwellings.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**30 MRSA § 3221, sub-§ 1, ¶B**, as last amended by PL 1977, c. 630, § 4, is further amended by inserting at the end the following new sentence:

**Municipalities may provide by ordinance that a holding tank may be used for a new seasonal dwelling or a commercial or industrial establishment with minimum employee facilities, provided the applicable rules promulgated by the Department of Human Services are compiled with.**

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to allow a municipality to determine if it shall allow holding tanks for new seasonal dwellings providing they are properly maintained.
