Amend the bill in the 7th line (5th line in L.D.) by underlined striking out the/word "biannual" and inserting in its place the underlined word 'biennial'

Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

'Fiscal Note

The bill would establish a Dedicated Revenue Account to assist with the cost of administering this program.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment changes the requirement for paying a soil evaluator license fee from \$40 every 6 months to \$40 every 2 years.
