SENATE AMENDMENT "D" to S.P. 401, L.D. 1161, Bill, "AN ACT to Make Corrections of Errors and Inconsistencies in the Laws of Maine."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of sections 221 and 222.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to remove sections 221 and 222 from the bill as it was not necessary to repeal the name used in earlier private and special laws as they were created for a limited duration. The inconsistency claimed between earlier Acts and the permanent commission established by private and special law 1975, chapter 147, Part G, section 2, doesn't appear to exist.
