STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Extend World War Assistance to Single Veterans.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

37-A MRSA § 29, as amended by PL 1975, c. 701, § 20, is further amended by adding after the first sentence a new sentence to read:

Aid shall also be granted under sections 28 to 37 to the needy disabled veteran who does not have a spouse, child, parent or parents living and who is a resident of the State.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill extends world war assistance to single veterans.
