COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 979, L.D. 1192, Bill,
"AN ACT to Enable Town Meetings to be Held Outside the Corporate
Limits Subject to Certain Limitations."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the amending
clause and inserting in its place the following:

'6. Location of meetings. Town meetings may be held outside
the corporate limits of the municipality if the proposed location is
within an ~~adjacent-municipality-and~~ adjoining or nearby municipality,
is not more than 25 miles from the corporate limits of the
municipality holding the meetings, is reasonably accessible to all
voters of the town and if the municipal officers determine that there
is no adequate facility for the meeting within the municipality.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment makes the language of the bill more specific
and provides more flexibility in the choice of a municipality
in which to hold town meetings.
