STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Enable Town Meetings to be Held Outside the Corporate Limits Subject to Certain Limitations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § 2054, sub-§ 6, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 232, is amended to read:

6. Location of meetings. Town meetings may be held outside the corporate limits of the municipality if the proposed location is within an adjacent municipality and is reasonably accessible to all voters of the town the school administrative unit in which the municipality is included and if the municipal officers determine that there is no adequate facility for the meeting within the municipality.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this legislation is to enable town meetings to be held outside the corporate limits of a municipality, provided that the proposed location is within the school administrative unit in which the municipality is included.
