COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 397, L.D. 1215, Bill, "AN ACT to Create a Ground Water Protection Commission to Review the Laws Dealing with Ground Water."

Amend the bill in section 3 by striking out all of the 2nd sentence and inserting in its place the following:

'One member representing industry shall be from a water company, one shall be a well driller and one shall be from the construction industry.'

Further amend the bill in section 4 by inserting after the 3rd sentence the following:

'One member representing industry shall be appointed by the Home Builders Association of Maine.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment designates that one of the industrial representation the Ground Water Protection Commission shall be appointed by the Home Builders Association of Maine.
