#### STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

### AN ACT to Exempt Financial Institutions from the Motor Vehicle Dealers Licensing Requirements.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 29 MRSA § 342, 3rd ¶, as amended by PL 1975, c. 731, § 30, is further amended to read:

Failure to obtain such a license or to comply with any provision of sections 347 or 348-A shall be a misdemeanor Class D crime.

- Sec. 2. 29 MRSA § 342, sub-§ 1 is enacted to read:
- 1. Exception. Financial institutions, including banks, savings and loan associations and credit unions, which are state or federally chartered, are exempted from this section when selling vehicles repossessed pursuant to section 2374.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill would exempt financial institutions from possible criminal liability when selling repossessed motor vehicles.
