HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1000,
L.D. 1235, Bill, "AN ACT Authorizing a Study to Determine the
Feasibility of Establishing a System of Youth Hostels."

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 4
and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 4. Appropriation. The following funds shall be
appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the
purposes of this Act.

Unallocated \$6,000

All or part of these funds
shall be used only to the
extent that at least half
the amount will be reim-
bursed to the State by a
Federal Government agency.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment changes the appropriation to \$6,000 which
is the amount needed to fund the study.
Federal funds to cover half of the amount are expected to be
available on a reimbursement basis rather than a matching
basis.
