STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Provide a Maine Earned Income Credit for Taxpayers with Low Income.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

36 MRSA § 5131 is enacted to read:

§ 5131. Earned income credit

For taxable years beginning on and after January 1, 1980, a resident may receive a credit against state taxes due equal to 20% of any credit he received for that year under the United States Internal Revenue Code, Section 43, earned income credit.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill grants to Maine residents a state tax credit of 20% of the federal earned income credit. This credit which could not exceed \$100 would be payable to low income persons even though the taxpayer was not liable for state income taxes.
