COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 418, L.D. 1290, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning the State Claims Board."

Amend the Bill in section 5 by striking out all of the 2nd paragraph after the amending clause and inserting in its place the following:

'After the appeal period from the decree of the State

Claims Board or a judgment of any court has expired, any sum

of money directed by a decree of the board or by a judgment

of any court to be paid over, which remains unclaimed for 60

days, shall be disposed of consistent with Title 33, chapter 27.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that any money directed to be paid over by a decree of the board or a judgment of a court, which is unclaimed for 60 days, shall be disposed of under provisions of the Abandoned Property laws.
