STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Reduce the Charges for Public Pay Telephones.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

35 MRSA § 107 is enacted to read:

§ 107. Telephone charges for local calls

No telephone company shall make, exact, demand or collect any rate, toll or charge of more than 10c for the use of any public pay telephone when making a local telephone call within the immediate area serviced by that company.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to limit the charge for making a local call on a pay telephone to 10¢.
