STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Better Reflect True Education Costs by Reducing Transportation Reimbursement to School Units for Noninstructional Purposes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

20 MRSA § 4743, sub-§ 22-A is enacted to read:

22-A. Transporation costs. "Transportation costs," for subsidy purposes, shall not include costs incurred by the administrative units for extra curricula activities, including athletic events, but shall be limited to the actual costs incurred for transporting students to and from school to attend classes and for field trips which are part of the administrative unit's curriculum.
