HOUSE AMENDMENT " H " to S. P. 456, L.D. 1369, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Contracts of Town Managers."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of subsection 1 and inserting in its place the following:

'1. Contract; term. The town manager shall hold office
for a definite term as specified by a contract with the
municipality. The municipal officers shall execute the contract.
The municipal officers may reappoint the town manager to another
term at the expiration of the contract.'

## Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that a town manager shall hold office for a definite term which shall be specified in a contract with the municipality and provides that the municipal officers may reappoint the town manager at the expiration of the contract.
