COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 443, L.D. 1381, Bill, "AN ACT to Increase Real Estate Broker and Salesman License and Examination Fees and to Eliminate Ambiguities."

Amend the bill in section 2, in that part designated "§4107" in subsection 1, by striking out all of paragraphs A and B and inserting in their place the following:

'A. Examination and 1 retake.....\$40'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to retain the provisions in current law which provides that an applicant who fails the licensing exam may retake it another time at no additional charge.
